- Able to take direction and pay attention to detail?

- Report no later than 5:00 a.m. to prepare your precinct to open on time?
- Lift 40 pounds to set up voting machines?
- Assist voters throughout the day in a non-partisan manner?
- Operate voting machines and electronic poll books?
- Tally and report precinct results?
- Stay until all closing duties are complete?
